I See You.

You've thought about working from home. You've googled it at 11pm when everyone else is asleep. You've wondered what it would look like to be the one who teaches your kids instead of dropping them off and hoping for the best.

But then the doubts show up.

"What if I can't find remote work? What if I'm not qualified? What if my kids fall behind? What if we can't afford it? What if I'm just not the type of person who gets to have that kind of life?"

I know those thoughts. I've had every single one of them.

And I'm here to tell you — they are lying to you. You are exactly the type of person who gets to have this life. And this guide is your proof.

Our Story in 60 Seconds

I didn't stumble into the remote life. I chose it — over a decade ago, before it was trendy, before the world had a name for it, and long before a global pandemic made everyone else realize it was possible.

For more than ten years, I have been building my life around freedom, flexibility, and faith. Working from my own space, on my own terms, showing up fully for the people and the purpose God placed in front of me. No commute. No office politics. No missing the moments that matter.

And then our family grew. And the question became — how do we protect this for them too? So we chose to homeschool. We kept our son home, at the table with us, learning in a way that fits who he actually is. We chose presence over convenience, purpose over performance, and a life that is fully, unapologetically ours.

Here is what that life looks like for our family:

- ◆ We are together — every single day, by choice
- ◆ Our son learns at his own pace, in his own way, with us beside him
- ◆ I run a business, earn income, and still make it to the school table every morning
- ◆ We travel when we want, rest when we need to, and answer to our own calendar
- ◆ Our faith is woven into every lesson, every conversation, every ordinary Tuesday
- ◆ We are not waiting for someday — we are living it right now

This is the life I have been building for over a decade. And now I want to show you exactly how to build yours. You do not need ten years. You just need a guide who has already walked the road — and is reaching back to bring you with her.

That is exactly why this guide exists. And it is exactly why I built what is waiting for you at the end of it.

The 3 Lies Keeping You Stuck

Lie #1 — "I need special skills or a degree to work remotely."

The truth: Most remote work doesn't require a degree. It requires reliability, communication, and a willingness to learn. Virtual assistants, customer service reps, social media managers, online tutors, writers, bookkeepers — these are real remote jobs that real people with no fancy credentials are doing right now. Skills can be learned. You probably already have more than you think.

Lie #2 — "My kids will fall behind if I homeschool them."

The truth: Research consistently shows that homeschooled children perform at or above grade level academically — and more importantly, they grow up knowing who they are. You don't need a teaching degree. You need to know your child, stay consistent, and use the right resources. Your kids don't need a perfect teacher. They need you.

Lie #3 — "We can't afford to make this change."

The truth: Most families can't afford NOT to make this change — in time, presence, and peace of mind. Remote income can match or exceed a traditional salary. The transition takes planning, not perfection. Starting before you feel ready is exactly how it gets done.

Your Remote Work Options

There are three paths into remote income. Pick the one that fits your life right now.

Path 1 — Get a Remote Job

Work for a company, fully online. Steady paycheck, set hours, no client hunting.

Best for: families who want income stability while transitioning

Where to look: We Work Remotely, Remote.co, FlexJobs, LinkedIn (filter: remote)

Examples: customer service, project coordinator, data entry, online teaching, HR, accounting

Path 2 — Freelance

Offer a skill to multiple clients on your own schedule. More flexibility, more hustle upfront.

Best for: families who want full control over their hours

Where to start: Upwork, Fiverr, direct outreach on LinkedIn

Examples: virtual assistant, copywriter, graphic designer, social media manager, bookkeeper

Path 3 — Build Your Own

Create digital products, courses, or a service-based business — or even a physical business you run on your own terms. Takes longer but creates the most freedom long term. Your income works even when you are at the school table or on a family trip.

Best for: families playing the long game who want income that doesn't stop when they do

Where to start: identify what you know, what you have lived, and what people already ask you about

Examples: online courses, coaching, content creation, Etsy digital products, membership communities, passion-based physical business

Not sure which path fits you? That is exactly what we work through together inside the core course.

What Homeschooling Actually Looks Like

Myth: You need to be a certified teacher. Reality: You need to know your child and show up consistently. Curriculum does the heavy lifting. You provide the love, the presence, and the direction.

Myth: Your kids will be isolated and weird. Reality: Homeschooled kids join co-ops, sports teams, community groups, music lessons, and more. Socialization is not a homeschool problem — it is a homeschool choice.

Myth: It takes all day. Reality: Most families finish in 2-4 hours. Without transitions and crowd management, learning is fast and focused. The rest of the day is yours.

Myth: It will ruin your relationship with your kids. Reality: For most families, it deepens it. You will know your child in ways you never imagined.

The Hard Truth About Modern Schools

Public school curricula in many parts of North America have shifted dramatically. Gender ideology introduced to children as young as five. Explicit content in school libraries. Worldviews that directly contradict Biblical truth — presented as fact, without your knowledge or consent. You are not extreme for wanting better. You are a parent doing exactly what parents are supposed to do.

A 2023 National Center for Education Statistics survey found that concern about the school environment is one of the TOP reasons parents choose homeschooling — and that number grows every year.

Time Is Fleeting. The Clock Started the Day They Were Born.

	Traditional School	Homeschool
Meaningful time with parent/year	600–800 hrs	2,500–3,000 hrs
Total ages 5–18	~8,000–10,000 hrs	~32,000–39,000 hrs

NHERI research: homeschooled students score 15–30 percentile points HIGHER on standardized tests and report significantly higher life satisfaction as adults.

Homeschooling is a decision about who gets your child's most formative hours — and who shapes the person they become. Choose wisely. Choose intentionally. Choose them.

A Real Day in Our Life

No 5am alarms. No rushing out the door. No stress hangover before 8am. This is just... our life.

8–10am	<p>We Wake Up When Our Bodies Are Ready</p> <p>Some days 8am, some days 10 — because we rested until we were actually rested. That alone changed everything.</p>
Morning	<p>We Start With Each Other</p> <p>Breakfast together first. We talk about the day, set the tone as a family. Some days we play. Some days mom and dad open laptops while Greight does his own thing. No rigid script. Just us, present.</p>
Mid-Morning	<p>School — Fast and Focused</p> <p>Some days every subject, some days one or two depending on Greight's learning pattern that day. Done in about two hours. Sometimes less. Every minute intentional, every lesson just for him.</p>
Afternoon	<p>We Go Live Our Life</p> <p>Parks, walks, nature, fresh air. Throughout the week: taekwondo, swimming, field trips, museums, family outings. Life is not scheduled around school — school is scheduled around life.</p>
Always	<p>Less Stress. As Close to Zero as Possible.</p> <p>Faith woven into every day. Values taught through real conversation. Bodies that move and play. A low-stress home is a daily decision — and one of the greatest gifts you give your family.</p>

Your days will look different from ours. The goal is not to copy our schedule — it is to build one that feels like freedom for your specific family.
